Supply List:

- ScotchBlue™ Painter's Tape
- Primer
- Chalkboard paint
- Small roller brush
- Small edging brush

Step 1

Tape off your wall using ScotchBlue™ Painter's Tape and give it a coat of primer.

Step 2

Then, using a small foam roller, apply the chalkboard paint. Use two coats to make it dark and rich. The roller worked great for the wall, but I still needed a small brush for the edges.



Step 3

After letting the coat dry, gently peel off the tape to show your beautiful straight lines!
