## Project: Embellish with a Paint Border

### Painting a border adds color and character

I bought this chalkboard speech bubble from a handmade shop a couple years ago, but I never really knew what to do with the sign – it felt incomplete. Then I realized what my sign really needed was a little color around the edge! Embellishing this plain sign with a colored border was all I needed to bring it to life!



### Supply List:

- ScotchBlue™ Painter's Tape
- Spray paint or paint
- Paintbrush
- Plastic cover
- Wall hooks
- X-Acto knife

### Step 1

First, put ScotchBlue™ Tape along the sides of the chalkboard. Use an X-Acto knife to cut off excess tape around the corners.

### Step 2

If using spray paint for the border, use painter's tape to secure a plastic covering over the top surface.

If using a paintbrush, go ahead and paint your border!



### Step 3

Spray or paint the chalkboard with three thin coats of paint, remove the painter's tape and let dry.

Once dry, add hooks to the chalkboard and it will be ready to hang in your home!
