ITEMS:

- Rust-Oleum Painter's Touch 2X Ultra Cover Spray Paint in Gloss Spring Green
- Magnetic board
- Chalkboard frame
- Wall shelf
- Drop cloth
- Sanding sponge
- Painter's tape
- Disposable Nitrile gloves

STEPS:

PREPARE: Always work in a well-ventilated area and use a drop cloth to protect from overspray. Sand the wood border of the frames and cover the areas you don't want to paint with painter's tape. Remove hooks from the organizer before painting.

PAINT: Shake can for 1 minute after the ball begins to rattle. Hold can 8-12" from the surface and spray in a steady back and forth motion, slightly overlapping each stroke. Apply 2 or more light coats a few minutes apart for best results with an even finish.

FINISH: Allow to dry for 20 minutes and then remove the tape. Let the whole project dry completely for about an hour. Replace hooks and hang the completed command center to enjoy your simplified and organized home.
