PATIO FURNITURE RENEWAL

Don't get stuck with the boring color on your patio set this season. Rust-Oleum Stops Rust Spray Paint lets you brighten up your patio with a few easy steps.

ITEMS:

- Rust-Oleum Stops Rust Gloss Protective Enamel Spray Paint in Gloss Light Turquoise
- Patio set
- Drop cloth
- Sanding sponge
- Lint-free cloth
- Disposable Nitrile gloves

STEPS:

Step 1: Always work in a well-ventilated area and use a drop cloth to protect from overspray.

Step 2: Sand down any spots on the patio set with loose paint or rust to create a smooth surface for the paint.

Step 3: Shake the can of Rust-Oleum Stops Rust Gloss Protective Enamel Spray Paint for 1 minute after the ball begins to rattle to mix the paint evenly.

Step 4: Apply 2-3 light coats of paint onto the items holding the can approximately 10-16" from the surface for a durable, long-lasting finish. Additional coats can be applied within the hour or after 48 hours.

Step 5: Allow the items to dry for about 1 hour before handling and 24 hours before sitting on your new patio set.

Tip: Apply a few light coats of Rust-Oleum Stops Rust Clean Metal Primer or Rusty Metal Primer (for heavily rusted surfaces) before spray painting to maximize rust protection on your outdoor metal project.
