DIFFICULTY: INTERMEDIATE

DURATION: 2 HOURS

WHAT YOU NEED FOR THIS JOB

- 1/4" plywood
- Jigsaw
- Garland
- Ribbon
- Sandpaper
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun with glue sticks
- 3/8" wood boring bit

STEP 1

Decide what letter you want to make. Choose any letter that you like. Then, with a pencil, draw your letter on the ¼-inch plywood. Try to draw the letter about 17 inches tall and 12 inches wide so that the small lines of the letter are larger than three inches.



STEP 2

Use your jigsaw to cut out the letter. If you have a letter with a hole in it, like R, B, D, or A, use the three-eighths-inch wood boring bit in the hole first. Then finish cutting out the hole with the jigsaw.



STEP 3

Use sandpaper to smooth the edges and remove any roughness or splinters.

STEP 4

Wrap the letter with garland. It's best to start at the bottom of the letter so that the garland can easily wrap around it.



STEP 5

Now that the letter is wrapped, use scissors to trim loose or extra garland. Tuck the end of the garland under the backside of the letter. Use a hot glue gun to secure the beginning and end of your wrapped garland to ensure it stays in place. Now your monogram garland wreath is ready to hang and enjoy.
